





SECTION TWO: 3 Divisions



3 DIVISIONS: ALL people, everywhere, have 3 internal "divisions"... The Head, Heart, & Hands unite to define & describe our lives. That's why healthy Christianity & biblical discipleship intentionally informs, inspects & inspires all 3 divisions.



"The HANDS" represent a person's actual & active walk, work & war-faring witness.



2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <u>17</u>so that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

INTRO:

Before we begin to focus on the "HANDS," we must first remember and revisit the FLOW's multidimensional context. Herein we are reminded that section one began with the "One Divine Design" – also known as the Gospel and its biblical worldview. Next, we moved on to section two, with its "Three Divisions: HEAD, HEART, and HANDS." Now, with the HEAD and HEART "divisions" addressed in our previous lessons, we are ready to concentrate on the HANDS, the third and final division of this section's 3-legged, theological stool. With that said, never forget – without all three legs (HEAD, HEART, and HANDS – also known as truth, love, and works) the stool is not trustworthy... it will eventually fall.

CONTEXT:

Macro

God's Word is filled, from cover to cover, with commands and exhortations, calling humanity to live with a passionate and predominate posture of humble, faithful obedience. Beginning in the Garden of Eden, the LORD promised to bless His people thru right-hearted relationships and hard work (Genesis 1:28). Similarly, in verses 18-19 of Revelation chapter 22, some of the very last words in the last chapter of the last Book of the Bible, God declares: "I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: 'If anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.""

Message

1. HIS Hands

Illustration

Let Your Life Speak

...The Quakers have a saying about calling that I love: "Let your life speak." Finding your calling is about finding your voice... Calling isn't something you choose, like who you marry or what house you buy or what car you buy; it's something you unearth.

You excavate. You dig out. And you discover. We usually ask little kids, What do you want to be when you grow up? I wonder if we're setting them up for failure with that question. Maybe a better question is, Who are you? What do you think God made you to do when you grow up? That, my friends, is the question. Who are we? How are we hardwired by our Maker?

What is it that God had in mind the day we were born? These are the questions of calling and vocation. I was brought up in a culture that essentially said, John Mark, you can do anything you put your mind to. If you work hard enough, if you believe in yourself, if you're patient, you can do anything. This is such a middle-class-and-above American way to think. Nobody in the developing world would ever talk like that...

...It's also dangerous because, sadly, it's not true. I can't be anything I want to be, no matter how hard I work or how much I believe in myself. All I can be is me. Who the Creator made John Mark to be. If we fight the image of God in us — even if we succeed in the short run — it will come back to eat us alive.

EXPLANATION

The "HANDS" of true Christians reveal and reflect the true love of God.

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. – James 1:17

In short, as Jesus boldly and unapologetically proclaimed in John 15:5 "apart from Me you can do NOTHING." Let that sink in. Nothing means nothing.

Stated in the context of our lesson, without the sacrificial and sustaining work of Christ, nothing attempted or completed, regardless of how good it looks or feels, has ever been an authentic byproduct of God's blessing. No. Instead, whatever "fruit," (in any and all cases), comes from non-abiding and disobeying motives and/or methods, is at best, plastic fruit, and at worst, rotting, man-made counterfeit fruit. If it's not of Christ, it's not Christian!

The success or failure of our work as a church or mission depends, in the last resort, largely, not in the number of preachers we put into the field, nor on the size of our congregations, but rather on the character of Christianity we and our work produce.

2. HOLY Hands

Explanation

As noted above, the true "HANDS" of God are His HANDS...

To expand that truth and begin to bring the core characteristics of His HANDS into focus, it is imperative that we see His call for HOLY HANDS in our understanding of Christianity (and the biblical worldview).

To be clear, that is not to say that all Christians' HANDS are perfect or holy in the purest sense. Instead, it is to establish holiness as a bullseye, an ideal, the ultimate objective in all that is undertaken.
