The Fight

The FIGHT: Life can be hard sometimes... For both the Christian & the non-Christian, spiritual warfare is real.

Scripture is clear... the world, the flesh, & the Devil are going to fight against us, both before AND after the cross.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <u>17</u>so that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

INTRO:

Welcome to Come And See Christianity's section four, "The DETAILS." At this point, we have already established in sections 1-3 that Almighty God has "1 Divine DESIGN" (found in His authentic biblical worldview) for all of creation. Next, we addressed the fact that every human being is made up of "3 DIVISIONS," their HEAD, HEART, and HANDS (also known as their beliefs, their beloved, and their behaviors). From there, we moved on to the "5 DISCIPLES," the LOST, LOVERS, LEARNERS, LEADERS, and LIFERS, which proved that Christianity accounts for, with definitions and descriptions, ALL people... past, present, and future, from ALL parts of the world – bar none.

With our Creator and all His image-bearing (Genesis 1:27) creatures accounted for, the next logical step on the narrow path of understanding will concentrate on the sure-footedness of core, non-negotiable, and eternally essential content. In short, we need to know what we need to know.

To that end, The DETAILS will define and describe, in a broad and biblical context, (7) seven progressive principles of God's truth in love (Ephesians 4:15) that serve to engage, explain, equip, empower, and exemplify the fundamentals of Christianity. Herein, we will unveil and unpack a comprehensive summary and cohesive overview of God's biblical blueprint for understanding His created reality. Having said that, in moving forward, to help paint the fuller portrait of genuine Christianity, each DETAIL will receive its own lesson. Herein, we will focus on #4, **The FIGHT.**

CONTEXT:

Macro

When it comes to learning about Christ, Christianity, and the biblical Church, relatively speaking, a thousand lifetimes filled with devoted study would not dig through the endless depths of God's divine grace, gospel, and glory. Frankly (and thankfully), the fullness of Creator Christ is far beyond our ability to fully comprehend. To quote Him directly and prove the point, hear Almighty God, "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundations?" (Job 38:4). In short, we need to maintain a sense of genuine awe and reverent fear (1 Peter 1:17) when it comes to loving and learning about the LORD.

At the same time, the character, commands, and commissioning of the living God, Christianity's Christ and King, compels us to draw near to Him (James 4:8) with the promise that He will draw near to us. Moreover, the God of the Bible promises that He has miraculously given all true Christians "everything needed for life and godliness" (2 Peter 1:3), which includes an anointed understanding of His Word, will, and ways (1 Corinthians 2:14).

NOTE: the unification and blessed tension of the two paragraphs above can be harmonized when one realizes how these truths complement each other. On one hand, there are (7) fundamental details that share a progressive and straight-forward, principle-based explanation of Christianity. And, at the same time, all (7) have a divine depth and truth-filled treasure that is both bottomless and priceless – Amen!

- 2. The FRAMEWORK
- 3. The FACTS
- 4. The FIGHT
- 5. The FAITH
- 6. The FAMILY
- 7. FOREVER


Micro

Life in this sin-soaked world is hard. As we learned in our previous lesson (The FACTS), when CORRUPTION came into God's creation it affected EVERY-thing and EVERY-one. Make no mistake, ever since Satan and sin seduced Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:1-15) all of God's created order, especially the human condition, has been in desperate need of a Savior, whose sanctifying work would bring revelation, restoration, and divine redemption.

In short, a spiritual war has been, and continues to be, raging (Ephesians 6:10-20)... a war for the glory of God, His truth in love (Ephesians 4:15), the spread of Christ's Gospel (Mark 16:15), the making of disciples (Matthew 28:18-20), the salvation of souls (John 8:32 and 36), the work of the ministry (Ephesians 2:10), and the empowered, attracting witness of the true Christian Church (Acts 1:8).

With that said, understanding the origins, outcrops, and overcoming (Romans 8:37) narrow ways to victory (Matthew 7:13-14) in spiritual warfare are essential for all who hope to remain healthy and helpful on the battlefields of life. If we do not understand the destructive and potentially damning struggle that defines spiritual warfare, we are not apt to triumph in the applied "truth in love" of God's Word, will, and ways (Proverbs 3:5-6).

Thus, in this lesson, we will see that Christ and His cross lie at the center (once again) of our faith and focus... especially when it comes to The FIGHT. To be sure, not only is The Gospel of Jesus Christ missionally defined and best described through the work of The Cross, but Calvary also divides everything associated with cultural crowds vs. biblical churches, Satan vs. our Savior, sin vs. salvation, self-justification vs. God's sanctification... all that is good vs. all that is evil, and ultimately, the broad road that leads to hell vs. the narrow path to heaven.



While the reality of spiritual warfare, at the root level, has always been about God's glory vs. sin's story... about right vs. wrong and about love vs. lies... there are other aspects that need to be understood as well. Case in point, we need to rightly assess and righteously embrace the biblical "offense," "defense," and "beautiful brilliance" of the battlefields upon which we FIGHT. Moreover, as depicted in the lesson's visual graphic, there is a polarizing and progressive dynamic in spiritual warfare. In other words, the two opposing sides are constantly pulling in opposite directions, even after Christians have been born again. See here, **the fight will not end in this life.**

Let us now look to the (7) progressive stages of spiritual warfare:

- 1. Sovereignty
- 2. Satan
- 3. *Sin*
- 4. Self
- 5. Savior
- 6. Seducers
- 7. Sanctification

In the end, we all need to know that whether we like it or not... and/or whether we realize it or not... Life is going to be a fight to the finish!

1. SOVEREIGNTY

Illustration:

Whatsoever is good for God's children they shall have it; for all is theirs to help them towards heaven; therefore, if poverty be good they shall have it; if disgrace or crosses be good they shall have them; for all is ours to promote our greatest prosperity.

Explanation:

Everything in reality is under the ultimate control of God's sovereignty.

If you KNOW that Creator Christ has one divine DESIGN... and couple that truth with the FACT that He is the Creator and Sustainer of ALL things (Colossians 1:17 & Hebrews 1:3), therein you can have a peace that passes understanding (Philippians 4:7), even on, or better stated, <u>especially</u> on the battlefield.

3. SIN

Illustration:

99% obedience is 100% disobedience!

Sin is often flavored with spiritually poisonous, artificial sweeteners.

Explanation:

Simply put, sin is anything and everything that goes against the Word, will, and ways of God (1 John 3:4; Deuteronomy 9:2; Joshua 1:18). Sin is the rotten fruit that comes from the roots of rebellion and various degrees of unbelief. Biblically defined, sin is missing the mark of God's divine will and ways, as declared and described in His Word.

Sin is Satan's greatest weapon in spiritual warfare (Genesis 3). At the same time, sin is humanity's number one problem (Revelation 20:11-15)... To that end, sin is universally pervasive (Romans 3:23). Sin is embedded in all human DNA (Romans 5:12 & 18) and sin carries an eternal (not just physical) death sentence (Romans 6:23).

Thankfully, as we will see when we focus on The SAVIOR, sin has a Solution... **His name is JESUS and His Gospel saves sinners!** Ephesians 1:7 declares this good news for all to hear and heed: "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our sins, according to the riches of His grace." This truth in love points to the Door (John 10:7) thru which humanity can escape the power and penalty of sin. Amen and AMEN!

5. SAVIOR

Jesus Christ is Creator God (John 1:1). Jesus Christ is the Architect of creation (John 1:10). Jesus Christ defines and sustains reality (Colossians 1:17). Jesus Christ is humanity's only divine LORD and eternal SAVIOR (John 14:6 and Romans 10:9)... While an inconceivable list of biblical superlatives could continue without end, suffice it to say, Jesus Christ is The Answer to and Authority over all questions and challenges pertaining to spiritual warfare.

6. SEDUCERS

Illustration:

Seducers are more dangerous enemies to the church than persecutors.

Explanation:

SEDUCERS are those who draw us away from God's Word, will, and ways. With that said, it is important to note from the onset that while most SEDUCERS are overt enemies of God, wolves in sheep's clothing (Acts 20:29 and Matthew 7:15), not all SEDUCERS are intentional in their destructive behavior. To be clear, biblical "wolves in sheep's clothing" seek to deceive and destroy, like their "father the devil" (John 8:44). So true and tricky is this

FACT that God's Word goes so far as to warn us that Satan and his minions can and will come down into our earthly context and battles "disguised as angels of light" (2 Corinthians 11:14-15).

Having duly noted the worst of the SEDUCERS, we need also address the spiritual "weeds" and "goats" who also tend to draw people away from the Lord's truth and love. Jesus warned in Luke 8:4-15 of the wants and worries of this world having a choking and killing affect on those who started in the direction of God's will and ways, only to be drawn away to a fruitless destruction. Similarly, Christ warned in Matthew 25:31-46 of those goats who thought themselves to be sheep. In both cases, the "weeds" and the "goats" tend to serve as Satan's SEDUCERS in the context of Christian pursuits. Herein, the "weeds" and "goats" tend to be real SEDUCERS, albeit without an overt awareness of their spiritual attacks.

The last category of SEDUCERS represents those struggling Christians who make grave mistakes and lead others away from God's biblical bullseyes as they stumble through their sin. The sad reality is that the world, the flesh, and the devil create much collateral damage in spiritual warfare by leading some to lead others off-track.

Instead of REPENTANCE, people are getting all kinds of counterfeit spiritual experiences. There seems to be almost no discernment at all.

7. SANCTIFICATION

Sanctification is here listed as the capstone in spiritual warfare because of God's sovereign design and love... In short, the all-knowing, all-present, and all-powerful Creator Christ knew that His faithful followers would be blessed by the refining FIGHTs in their lives (Romans 8:28-29). Stated differently, every FIGHT (on both the macro and micro level) has a God-honoring and Christian-strengthening purpose and promise behind it. Moreover, for faithful Christ followers, there is a guaranteed victory (Philippians 4:13) pre-woven into the fabric of every FIGHT.

Thus, for true Christians, spiritual warfare can be a beautiful context, out of which God receives glory (Galatians 2:20), the world receives a witness (John 20:21), and lives are biblically, missionally and eternally transformed (2 Corinthians 5:17-21).
