





SECTION FOUR: 7 Details








7 DETAILS: The <u>divine</u> is in the details... Here we have what we also call The Fundamentals, that which explains the core & comprehensive truths of Christianity, as well as a <u>biblical worldview</u>.

The FAITH: This is the "Stickman Gospel," a visual explanation of the exclusive & eternally unique "good news" of Jesus Christ. When you understand the "m M m" (miracle, Messiah, & mission), you understand Christianity:-)

2 Timothy 3:16-17

INTRO:

Welcome to Come And See Christianity's section four, "The DETAILS." At this point, we have already established in sections 1-3 that Almighty God has "1 Divine DESIGN" (found in His authentic biblical worldview) for all of creation. Next, we addressed the fact that every human being is made up of "3 DIVISIONS," their HEAD, HEART, and HANDS (also known as their beliefs, their beloved, and their behaviors). From there, we moved on to the "5 DISCIPLES," the LOST, LOVERS, LEARNERS, LEADERS, and LIFERS, which proved that Christianity accounts for, with definitions and descriptions, ALL people... past, present, and future, from ALL parts of the world – bar none.

With our Creator and all His image-bearing (Genesis 1:27) creatures accounted for, the next logical step on the narrow path of understanding will concentrate on the sure-footedness of core, non-negotiable, and eternally essential content. In short, we need to know what we need to know.

To that end, The DETAILS will define and describe, in a broad and biblical context, (7) seven progressive principles of God's truth in love (Ephesians 4:15) that serve to engage, explain, equip, empower, and exemplify the fundamentals of Christianity. Herein, we will unveil and unpack a comprehensive summary and cohesive overview of God's biblical blueprint for understanding His created reality. Having said that, in moving forward, to help paint the fuller portrait of genuine Christianity, each DETAIL will receive its own lesson. Herein, we will focus on #5, **The FAITH.**

CONTEXT:

Macro

When it comes to learning about Christ, Christianity, and the biblical Church, relatively speaking, a thousand lifetimes filled with devoted study would not dig through the endless depths of God's divine grace, gospel, and glory. Frankly (and thankfully), the fullness of Creator Christ is far beyond our ability to <u>fully</u> comprehend. To quote Him directly and prove the point, hear Almighty God, "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundations?" (Job 38:4). In short, we need to maintain a sense of genuine awe and reverent fear (1 Peter 1:17) when it comes to loving and learning about the LORD.

At the same time, the character, commands, and commissioning of the living God, Christianity's Christ and King, compels us to draw near to Him (James 4:8) with the promise that He will draw near to us. Moreover, the God of the Bible promises that He has miraculously given all true Christians "everything needed for life and godliness" (2 Peter 1:3), which includes an anointed understanding of His Word, will, and ways (1 Corinthians 2:14).

NOTE: the unification and blessed tension of the two paragraphs above can be harmonized when one realizes how these truths complement each other. On one hand, there are (7) fundamental details that share a progressive and straight-forward, principle-based explanation of Christianity. And, at the same time, all (7) have a divine depth and truth-filled treasure that is both bottomless and priceless – Amen!

- 2. The FRAMEWORK
- 3. The FACTS
- 4. The FIGHT
- 5. The FAITH
- 6. The FAMILY
- 7. FOREVER

If there is one thing, one truth, one reality that the world needs to hear, learn, believe, and embrace, it is The Gospel of Jesus Christ. In our Come And See Christianity curriculum, we engage and explain this eternity-defining truth in love (Ephesians 4:15) under the banner of The FAITH. Moreover, we use "The Stickman Gospel" to biblically detail and visually display Christ's Gospel and Christianity's FAITH.

In this lesson, while the three primary pillars of The Gospel (miracle, Messiah, and mission) will serve as our progressive outline, the seven components of the Stickman Gospel will here be detailed and described, in hopes of helping you to better understand the FAITH's full context and interconnectivity.

5 Components of The Stickman Gospel

1. **X / Dead Man:** Represents ALL PEOPLE born into sin.

2. **| / Ball and Chain:** Represents eternally blinding spiritual warfare.

3. † / **Cross of Christ:** Represents Christ's sacrificial death and atonement.

4. **Stickman w/ cross**: Represents ALL true Christians living on mission.

5. Arrows:

i. Small Arrow #1: God's elect being drawn to salvation.
 ii. Small Arrow #2: Saved sheep now being sanctified.
 iii. Tunnel Under Arrow: Way of wolves in sheep's clothing.
 iv. Jump Over Arrow: Path of sincerely deceived "goats."

Christ and His cross will always stand at the center of The FAITH, The Stickman Gospel, and the eternal fork in the road that separates heaven and hell. At the same time, it is important to note that The Gospel's application begins with God's loving and sovereign grace, followed by the heartfelt acknowledgment of human sin and humanity's desperate need for a Savior.

With those foundational truths established, we will now address our need for miracles, movement, and mission, which can be explained through the Stickman Gospel's different arrows and the Christ-like, cross-carrying Christian. To that end, do not miss the miraculous transformation that takes place (2 Corinthians 5:17-21) between the dead man at the beginning and the joyful missionary at the end (Ephesians 2:1-10). May the miraculous truth in love of our Messiah's mission, message, and methods bless you and build you up, all by God's grace and all for His glory. Amen






Original Stickman Gospel




Stickman Gospel 2.0




Spanish Stickman Gospel




Indian Stickman Gospel (Odia language)
