PREFACE:

How well do you understand what we are doing here?

If I hope to help you... and if you hope to help others... young and old, near and far, like us and not like us... then we need to begin by engaging how best to explain biblical & missional explaining... or better stated, how to equip equippers to equip effectively.

In short, if WE hope to help ANY and ALL people to understand God's plan & purposes for humanity, then we need to understand how to disciple warriors.

To that end, while we have developed other teaching & equipping tools that define effective CONTENT for biblical & missional discipleship, our aim here is to explain the universal CONTEXT of Christ-like equipping & discipleship.

INTRODUCTION:

The Bible... God's Word... is clear. The family of God, (theologically defined as the real, eternal Church), is also the army of God. Our ranks are made up of multi-generational, globally-diversified, cross-carrying, born-again, 'Discipled Warriors' who are to BE standard-bearing, missional-militia who get prayed-for, raised-up, & sent-out!

This Holy Spirit empowered & supernaturally unified family of 'truthing & loving' warriors lives by God's grace & for God's glory, all while sharing His Gospel & exponentially-multiplying His Christlike, biblical disciples... In short, discipled warriors seek to find and grow (a.k.a. "make") discipled warriors who will find and grow discipled warriors, who will find and grow discipled warriors... from birth till burial!

With that said, as with all instructional exercises, it is mission critical that we, at the onset, define our definitive terms, which are in this case, both "discipled" and "warriors."

DISCIPLED:

- A. <u>Generically</u>: (mechanical)
 - a. Someone impacted, shaped, trained, and/or equipped to be like another person or standard...
 - b. Generic discipleship has no inner, moral compass.
 - c. In one sense, everyone has been discipled...
 - d. In another sense, everyone is also discipling.
 - e. Note: not all discipling is *intentional* discipleship.
- B. <u>Biblically</u>: (miracle)
 - a. Biblical discipling was prioritized by Christ.
 - b. Biblical discipling was modeled by Christ.
 - c. Biblical discipling was commanded by Christ.
 - d. Biblical discipling was commissioned by Christ.
 - e. Biblical discipling was empowered by Christ.

C. Missionally: (ministerial)

- a. Biblical discipling is at the heart of our worship.
- b. Biblical discipling is at the heart of our walk.
- c. Biblical discipling is at the heart of our work.
- d. Biblical discipling is at the heart of our witness.
- e. Biblical discipling is at the heart of our warfare.

Discipleship:

(VERB)

The <u>intentional</u> endeavors of "miraculous, Christ-like, works-in-progress" (a.k.a. Disciples) <u>engaged</u> in "finding the lost AND growing the found" into family-members who are in-turn <u>committed</u> to making disciples, who make disciples, who make disciples... by God's grace & for His glory.



WARRIORS:

- A. <u>Generically</u>:
 - a. Warriors are active, intentional, combatants in a war effort... NOTE the plurality in the definition.
 - b. Warriors are normally trained & equipped for war, battles, and intense fighting in any context.
 - c. Warriors are to be contrasted with the *"uniforms,"* bystanders, pacifists, and genuine victims of war.

- B. <u>Biblically</u>:
 - a. Discipled warriors are found on both sides of the fight of faith... good and evil.
 - b. Christian, discipled warriors do not fight against flesh & blood... nor do we use worldly weaponry.
 - c. The living God's discipled warriors are to BE:
 - i. Truthing & Loving warriors
 - ii. Faithful & Fearless warriors
 - iii. Shrewd & Innocent warriors
 - iv. Bold & Courageous warriors
- C. <u>Missionally</u>:
 - a. Discipled warriors know, love & serve their King.
 - b. Discipled warriors are the King's and kingdom's devoted ambassadors .
 - c. Discipled warriors are miraculously-equipped and missionally-empowered soldiers who have been set apart, Spirit-filled & sent out by Christ.

OVERVIEW:

What would you do if tomorrow morning you found yourself on the surface of another planet... and you were told two breath-taking and life-transforming truths?

- 1). You have already received EVERYTHING you need to survive and thrive here.
- 2). It is your personal privilege AND responsibility to find and grow the next generation of darkness-penetrating, wilderness-taming, culture-creating missionaries.

Where would you begin? What would you do? In a parallel sense, one's principled response to the challenge described above would also be wise to apply to the privilege and responsibility every Christian has; namely, to BE and build discipled warriors. In short, from the broadest, practical perspective, down to the smallest biblical and missional detail, a very simple yet comprehensive, three step process should be trusted and applied.

because unless & until you personally understand God's application of <u>amazing grace</u> and His saving gospel...

You will remain in the eternally damning bondage of your **personal rebellion** and poisoned religion. "You **MUST** be born again."

DESCRIBE RESTORATION



From this overarching, always-applicable, 3-D (Define, Describe, & Develop) plan, we can refine and refocus our energy and efforts in all that we endeavor to do. In the case of making discipled-warriors, to include our concentration on CONTEXT and PERSPECTIVE, we have developed a seven (7) step *"Chain of Command"* that will effectively help Christian disciplers to connect the proverbial "dots" between *biblical "concepts" and missional "constructs."*







Discipling Warriors' <u>5 GUIDELINES</u>:

1. Our <u>Blueprint</u>: (God's Word, Will & Way)

We need to be 100% committed and 100% surrendered to the 100% authoritative, absolute "truth in love" (Ephesians 4:15) of God, as revealed in God's Word, will, and ways... We are to righteously affirm, obey, and exemplify 2nd Timothy 3:16-17.

2. Our <u>Belief</u>: (God's Grace & Gospel)

We need God's grace! Even more, by God's grace... we need to realize how much we desperately need God's saving gospel and sanctifying grace (Ephesians 2:1-10)... every step of the way, each and every day.

3. Our <u>Becoming</u>: (God's Witnesses)

We, like all true, born again, biblical-believers are miraculous, Christlike, <u>works in progress</u>. By God's grace and for His glory, we do our best to worship God & multiply... as we pray, obey, love, & repeat (Acts 1:8).

4. Our <u>Blessing</u>: (God's Service)

We want to serve God, in part, by meeting the biblical needs of others, serving them holistically & missionally, (Galatians 6:2) contextualizing & customizing truth in love... locally, regionally, & globally.

5. Our <u>Bullseye</u>: (God's Glory)

We aim to bless & glorify God by championing Christ, His Great Commandments, and His Great Commission... all in the context of winning spiritual warfare. In short, as radically intentional, biblical, and missional ambassadors, we are committed to bringing God glory by finding and growing more glorifiers (2 Corinthians 5:17-21).

The LOST

All who are wrongly & rebelliously related to the God of the Bible; the spiritually blind & stubborn; they are neither surrendered to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, nor filled with His Spirit. While such souls are often "religious" they remain <u>unrepentant</u>, <u>unbelieving</u>, <u>unfruitful</u> & <u>disobedient</u>. The "lost" are spiritually-dead sinners.

The LOVER

All born-again, Holy Spirit-filled, repentant & faithful "infant-followers" of the Lord Jesus Christ. Lovers are <u>miraculously</u> changed (while often missionally immature), in-filled but not fully informed; eternally saved but not yet missionally shaped. Lovers are <u>saved sinners</u> (aka biblical disciples) now ready-for and in need of maturing discipleship

The LEARNER

A born again, growing, fruit-producing, biblical follower of the Lord Jesus Christ; a spiritual adolescent (complete with their typical ups & downs). Discovery & development, amidst a dark & distracting world, are daily dynamics in the "learner's" life, as they are actively & intentionally discipled in how to live & love in the light of their new Christian identity.

The LEADER

A <u>stable</u>, born again, <u>spiritual-adult</u>; a disciple whose DNA & discipleship (both inward & outward) are producing a pattern of missional, Christ-like, servantoriented, multiplying-fruit, in the context of <u>faithfully following the Lord Jesus Christ</u>. Leaders are fishers of men; spiritual pillars, <u>koinonia-championing</u> chaperones; &/or spiritual "parents" in the family of God.


The LIFER

An imperfect but passionate, all-in, biblically-mature, fully devoted follower of the Lord Jesus Christ. Lifers are missionally & exponentially, fruitproducing, servant-leaders. Lifers are a God-given gift to the Church. 




