**VIDEO 2:** "The God Who Speaks Thru His Word"

"Certainty about the great issues of the Christian faith & conduct is lacking all along the line. The outside observer sees us as staggering on from gimmick to gimmick and stunt to stunt like so many drunks in a fog, not knowing at all where we are or which way we should be going...

Preaching is hazy, heads are muddled, hearts fret, doubts drain strength, and uncertainty paralyzes action. Unlike the first Christians who in 3 centuries won the Roman world, and the later Christians who pioneered the Reformation, and Puritan "Awakening," as well as the evangelical revivals and the great missionary movements of the last century...

we lack certainty. Why is this?

We blame the external pressures of modern secularism but that's like Eve blaming the serpent... (This is a matter of the heart). The real truth is that we have grieved the Holy Spirit and we stand under divine judgment. For generations, our churches have suffered from a famine... our churches have suffered from not hearing the Word of God."

I. God spoke to give us **PERSPECTIVE & PURPOSE** 

"Long ago... God spoke..."

The LORD spoke long ago... to give His people His perspective & His purposes...

This is the message of Hebrews = "Hold On"

- A. Hold On (to the WORD who IS God)
- B. Hold on (to the Word OF God)

### C. Hold on to your:

- ~ Worship and love of Christ
- ~ Want-to for God's glory
- ~ Walk of spiritual integrity
- ~ Work in kingdom service
- ~ Witness for Christ thru Christ-likeness

# II. God spoke to give us **PROMISE & PURITY**

"and **many times**... God spoke..."

The LORD has spoken countless times (<u>always</u>) to pass along <u>His</u> promises & press for <u>our</u> purity.

This is the detailed message of Leviticus... "BE Holy!"

**Leviticus 1:1-2a The LORD** called Moses and **spoke** to him **from** the tent of meeting...

Numbers 1:1 The LORD spoke to Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tent of meeting...

- Garden of Eden
- Great Flood

- Egypt, the Exodus, & inner evil
- David & the divided kingdom
- God-less perversions & godly prophets
- Dispersions & deliverance

# God spoke to give us **PERSEVERENCE & PASSION**

# Blackaby's 4 Primary Ways God Speaks:

- 1. Word of God (light for feet, lamp for path...)
- 2. Prayer
- 3. Children of God (unsolicited)
- 4. Circumstances

<u>5 Categories of God's Sovereign, Spoken-Diversity</u> (Miracles, Maintenance, Promises, Warning, Discipline)

The LORD has spoken in many ways to encourage our perseverance in purity and our passion in purpose!

In many ways, this pursuit of holy <u>justice & righteousness</u> is the message from the prophet Amos! - "Hear Me!"

- 7. Christ's Crucifixion (and resurrection)
- 8. Christ's Calling of Christian(s)
- 9. Community/Koinonia of Christians (John 17)
- 10. Christianity's Commissioning & Conflict
- 11. Christ's Church (ekklesia homothoomadon)
- 12. Christ's Celebration & Coming-again

**REVIEW:** "Long ago, at many times & in many ways God spoke..."

# **CLOSE:** God has spoken AND He still speaks today!

- Think about it... Jesus is "The Word"
- > The real question is NOT: Does God speak...
- > The really relevant question is Will WE LISTEN?
- Friend... will YOU "believe & obey?"

# John 3:36 says it all!

<u>Whoever</u> believes (biblically) in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not **obey** the Son will <u>NOT</u> see life, but the wrath of God **remain** on him.

### If that doesn't sound good to you... ask yourself WHY?
