

- > Jesus divided eternity, heaven & hell, by righteousness.





TEXT: Matthew 5:20-22

²⁰For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. ²¹ "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.' ²²But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

I. Righteous **CONDITION**

Matthew 5:20

²⁰For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven

II. Righteous CORRECTION

- v.20 is itself a pointed & eternal correction...
- > Then Jesus expressly corrects with the phrases...

21"You have heard that it was said... 22But I say to you..."

III. Righteous CLARIFICATION

21"You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.' 22But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

T/S: Let's intro & contextualize biblical anger...

- ➤ <u>Definition</u>: anger is an emotional feeling and response to a perceived injustice or that which evokes elevated displeasure.
- > Description:
 - **O CONSTRUCTIVE**
 - **O DESTRUCTIVE**
- > <u>Differentiation</u>:
 - o SINFUL
 - "whatever is not from faith is sin."
 - Romans 14:24
 - "The anger of man does NOT achieve the righteousness of God." – James 1:20
 - "All rash anger is heart-murder." -Henry
 - o RIGHTEOUS
 - Psalm 4:4 & Ephesians 4:26
 - Mark 3:5 = "Jesus was angry with them"

A. Layers of RIGHTEOUSNESS (v.20)

- a. Rotten righteousness
- b. **Resurrection** righteousness
 - i. 1 Peter 1:3
 - ii. Romans 10:4
 - iii. 2nd Corinthians 5:17-21

B. Layers of PEOPLE

- a. "You" (2X)
- b. "those of old"
- c. "I/Jesus" (2X)
- d. "whoever" (3X)
- e. "murders"
- f. "everyone"
- g. "the sinfully angry"
- h. "brother" (2X)

C. Layers of OFFENSE

- a. Murder
- b. Anger (sinful)
- c. **Insulting** (a form of reviling)
- d. Saying: "You fool!" (a form of slander)

D. Layers of "LIABLE"

- a. Local Council "judgment"b. National Sanhedrin "judgment"c. Eternal "hell of fire" "judgment"
 - i. "HELL" = Gehenna (place of perpetual fire)
 - ii. "FIRE" = The LORD is a consuming fire!
 - 1. Deuteronomy 4:24 (against you...)
 - 2. <u>Deuteronomy 9:3</u> (for you...)

3. Hebrews 12:28-29

Therefore, let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, 29 for our God is a consuming fire.

<u>Don't miss this...</u> the name caller & slanderer get the same eternal spiritual death as the earthly murderer!

CLOSE:

- 1. How do Christ & righteousness relate to anger?
 - a. There is a time, a place, & a way for anger...
 - b. ALL sinful anger is unrighteous & unacceptable.
 - c. Christ's resurrection righteousness is needed!

2. How do the BEATITUDES relate to anger?

- a. The bankrupt humility of the **poor in spirit** compel them to be ever slow to anger...
- b. Sin-mourners repent over their sinful anger.
- c. The **meek** are careful to control their anger...
- d. Those who **hunger & thirst after "R"** seek to ensure their anger truly glorifies God.
- e. The pure in heart express Christ-like anger.
- f. Peace-keeper's anger unites true Christians.
- g. The **persecuted**, **reviled**, **& slandered** resist sinful anger, persevering when they are hurt & attacked for holy & righteous witnessing.

3. For what? So what? Now what?

- a. Righteous anger always seeks God's glory!
 - i. 1st Corinthians 10:31
 - ii. Ephesians 4:1
- b. You live in a warzone filled with fights...
 - i. Matthew 10:16
 - ii. Romans 12:18 If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
- c. "As the Father has sent Me, so now, I send you!"
 - i. John 20:21
 - ii. Acts 1:8
 - iii. Matthew 28:18-20
 - iv. Titus 2:15
